The faintly copper-hued 2017 Luberon Blanc is a characterful blend of 25% each Clairette, Marsanne and Roussanne, plus 15% Grenache Blanc and 5% each Bourboulenc and Rolle (Vermentino). Hints of pear skin and cider appear on the nose, the medium-bodied palate is silky in texture and its loaded with pear and citrus flavors that finish long and spicy. This estate, which starred in Ridley Scott's film, "A Good Year," is turning out some excellent wines.

The finest red from this appellation I tasted this year, Chateau la Canorgue's 2016 Luberon combines pungent, savory notes of leather, clove, allspice, espresso and black olive with plummy fruit. A blend of 70% Syrah, 20% Grenache and 10% Carignan and aged in a combination of foudre and tank, it's medium to full-bodied, with silky, supple tannins and a long, cool finish. It should drink well for 5-6 years.
